

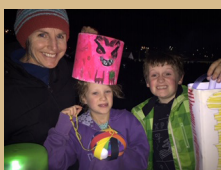

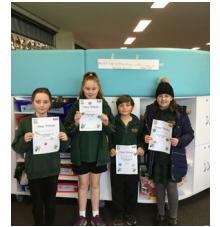
First Eucharist
