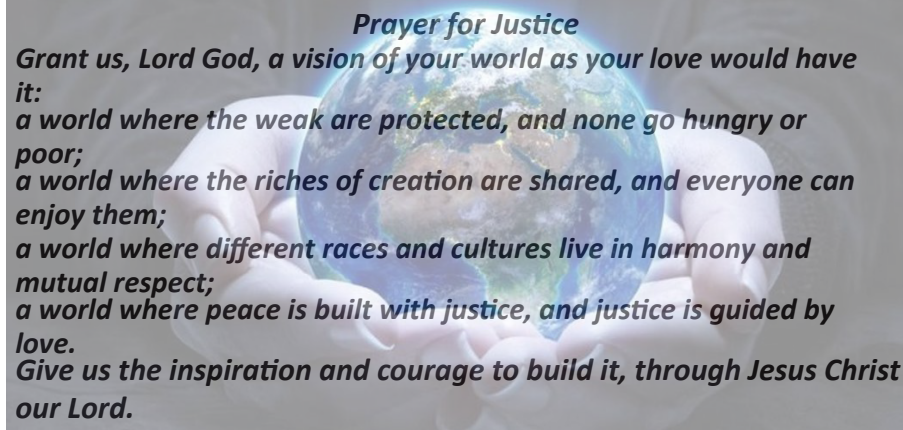

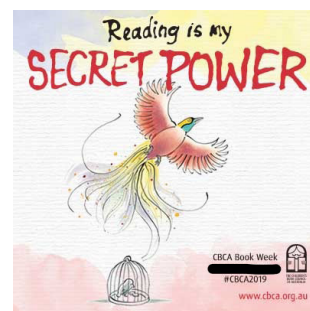

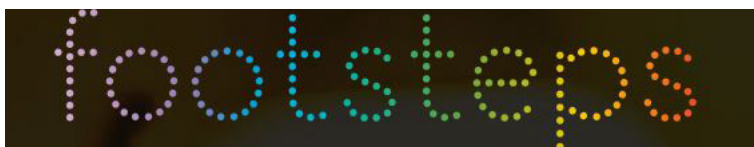
District Basketball

Uniform

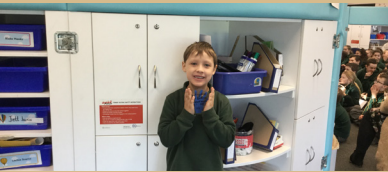
