#### Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are very aware that life is constantly changing often by the day at the moment and this can be very challenging for everyone to keep up. We will continue to provide you with information as it comes to hand.

Each day I receive an update from CEO Sale that has current advice about the COVID situation. Where it impacts the school, the information gets shared via CareMonkey. Please make sure you are checking CareMonkey on a regular basis. A CareMonkey was sent yesterday in regards to testing for COVID-19. Please see the key points below:

This is available for people who are displaying symptoms of coronavirus including fever, chills or sweats, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose and loss of sense of smell or taste.

If children, parents, guardians or carers do undergo testing for COVID-19, all children of the parent, guardian or carer should remain absent from school until a negative test result is received.

If students who are being tested for COVID-19 have siblings who attend a school managed and operated by the Diocese of Sale Catholic Education Limited (DOSCEL), then the siblings should also remain at home until a negative test result is provided for the student awaiting a test result.

The school will follow their normal processes for managing unwell students, if any child presents as being unwell at school the family will be contacted to collect them. We cannot stress enough that children should not attend school if they are unwell, even the mildest symptoms require them to stay home. We understand that it is difficult for parents to take time off work for very mild symptoms however we cannot be too careful in these times.

We are very grateful to our school community who are doing everything we ask to help reduce the spread of this virus. We understand that it is difficult not to come on the school site, attend masses, assemblies etc. We are constantly thinking of ways that we can continue to connect you with us.



Gr 3/4 classes have been creating a family crest during their art lessons, these have been done digitally and incorporate three types of symmetry - translation, rotation and/or reflection.


#### 5/6 News

This is a quick note to inform you that our digital forms and school operations platform provider, CareMonkey, will be rebranding as 'Operoo': School processes, without the paperwork.

The name change will occur the week beginning Monday August 3rd. How you use the service, will remain unchanged.

You can continue using the system, and its mobile application, as usual. Just be aware that, after Monday August 3rd, emails and notifications sent from the system will start appearing under the new name 'Operoo'. You will also be automatically diverted to the new Operoo website if you go to the old CareMonkey website.
