I am including a reminder regarding on-site supervision. There are specific guidelines released by the State Government regarding remote schooling. These state that all **students who can learn from home will be required to learn from home**.

The school will be open for:


- students where they are unable to be supervised from home and no other arrangements can be made as parents
 / guardians / carers are unable to work from home
- · vulnerable students will be determined by the Principal
- students with a disability who are receiving adjustments including, but not limited to, those supported through the Program for Students with Disabilities.

These conditions are subject to change.

The intent behind this is to ensure the safety of staff and students in schools, by limiting who can attend. If you are working from home, have a day off work, aren't working at the moment, are studying, or have access to alternative care arrangements, then your child cannot be accessing the on-site supervision.


We are trying our best to limit the number of adults on site to meet government guidelines however, we need your help with this.

If your child needs onsite supervision and meets one of the above criteria then you must complete the CareMonkey by the cut off time indicated on it so we can ensure correct ratios. A late notification after this time may result in your child(ren) not being able to attend as extra children affect the staff- student ratios.














STEM
