Cancellation of Student Activities: Important message about School Fees.

Cancellation of Student Activities

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic school camps for the remainder of 2020 have been cancelled. This includes the Gr 3/4

and 5/6 camps. Swimming programs (F-2) scheduled for term 4 have also been cancelled. Diocese of Sale Catholic Education Limited (DOSCEL) will continue to monitor the advice of the Victorian Government to ensure that the health and safety of staff and students remains the highest priority.

Credits for camps and the F-2 swimming program have been applied to fee accounts. Further credits will be applied as activities are cancelled. If this credit results in your fee account being overpaid the credit can be applied against 2021 school fees. In the case of grade 6 families who will no longer be at our school in 2021 a refund will be paid.
